Educational pieces: we have placed handwashing instructions in all common washrooms and have an elevator campaign in place

We are monitoring and following Health Canada recommendations

We've taken the following steps to protect our own team and invite you to incorporate any of the ideas that fit your work evnironment:

Stay home when sick – this is always our policy, but we've emphasized that we want our team members to take care of themselves when they are under the weather
